Our Story

The organization was founded when a 13 year-old boy had undergone surgery in December 2014 to remove a brain tumor. He sat in his hospital bed with his head partially shaved, staples and incision in full view. He felt self-conscious and wanted to cover his head when his friends came to visit. His friends and family rushed out to try to find a hat that fit his swollen head and also made him feel better. That hat was a beanie! Two weeks later the family learned of another little boy who had undergone surgery. The family mailed him three beanies to hopefully make him feel better if only for a minute.
